Brothers of Northern Plains Province,

I am sad to be missing this 10th meeting of NPP. While I wish I could be with you all.

I'm off on an adventure with my nephew to Europe for his graduation celebration. Hopefully I will see many of you at GCC and/or the fall Province Assembly. As for updates, for those of you reviewing ordinances this semester, one item to

consider is how has your chapter's organization and execution of meetings changed in recent years. For most of us, increased use of technology is either already in use for our meetings or being considered. Robert's Rules of Order does allow for meetings to take place electronically provided at a minimum everyone must be able to hear each other equivalent to those meeting in the same room. However, the use of electronic meetings should be noted as allowed in the Chapter's local ordinances. If you have not already updated your local ordinances for this option it is something to consider. In addition to adding it to the local ordinances Robert's Rules states rules should be created outlining your standards and process.

Most of our Chapters are also due to file taxes by May 15, 2017. Last year the IRS changed the submission process for filing taxes and all accounts needed to be recreated in the new system. There are several verification pieces of information now so note all of the information needed including the picture selected for your future Treasurers to be able to adequately confirm the account. The IRS was continuing to improve they system so changes may happen unexpectedly, please let me know if you run into issues with your filing. A common problem last year was that the form could not be submitted while on a shared internet system. For those chapters that bring in over.

\$50,000 per year and file the 990-EZ there is a new updated form with help icons to make the process easier. You can find all the details for how to create your accounts and submit the taxes on separate document entitled "Instructions for Chapters to File Taxes". Provinces will follow the same system as a Chapter.

Lastly a call will be out in the next few days for legislative proposals for GCC. Start thinking now about any submissions you want to consider and begin discussing it with your Chapter. I hope you have a productive assembly and safe travels home.
