 - No additions to By-Law V, Sec. 8 of the Uniform Province By-Laws
- Uniform Province By-Law V, Sec. 8:
 - A Grand Council Deputy of each Chapter within the Province, not sitting as a Province Officer or Graduate Chapter Delegate shall be a non-voting Member of the Province Assembly. Expenses of the Grand Council Deputies shall be reimbursed as provided in By-Law XIII, Ordinance 5.
- Proposed Legislation
 - The registration fee for one Grand Council Deputy per Northern Plains Province Chapter shall be paid by the Province. Grand Council Deputies sitting as Province Officers or Delegates are not eligible for Province reimbursement of expenses. Additional expenses of any Grand Council Deputy may be waived at the discretion of the host Chapter.

Rationale

- We don't currently define if GCDs will receive reimbursements. The proposal allows the province to budget for this expense.
